
OUT & ABOUT



The Gallery Lounge's exciting new exhibition, Women in the RACV Collection, brings together artists exploring identity, storytelling and abstraction. It features works by 10 artists: Del Kathryn Barton, Angela Brennan, Nadine Christensen, Julie Dowling, Katherine Hattam, Karen Mills, Lara Merrett, Vivienne Shark LeWitt, Jenny Watson and Heidi Yardley.

Established in 2003, the RACV Art Collection comprises more than 1,000 contemporary artworks created within the past two decades. The Collection has a nearly 50 per cent representation of female to male artists.

The exhibition presents a contrast of approaches, with artists such as Del Kathryn Barton, Heidi Yardley and Julie Dowling incorporating figurative elements that embellish traditional portraiture. Barton's layered, dreamlike works capture an ethereal beauty; Yardley's charcoal drawing asks viewers to look internally, while Dowling's powerful portrait explores Indigenous identity, culture and social justice.

Jenny Watson and Vivienne Shark LeWitt place their figures into wider landscapes, seeking to incorporate the locale and actions of women into their storytelling. Angela Brennan, Nadine Christensen and Katherine Hattam embrace colour, abstraction and personal histories to map out and understand their environments.

Karen Mills's works have a meditative quality, with the Australian landscape and her First Nations heritage inspiring her earthy, textured painting style. Lara Merrett's exploration of abstract colours and forms create immersive paintings that engage viewers in a sensory experience.

"These artists engage with both personal and societal narratives, offering reflections on the experiences of women and those who identify as women in contemporary life," says Ellen Wignell, RACV Visual Arts Curator. "Reflecting the International Women's Day 2025 theme: Accelerate Action, this exhibition celebrates women artists in the Collection and showcases the strength of each artist's voice. Highlighting these artists plays a part in advocating for the equal rights and empowerment of all."




AUSTRALIA'S TOP TRAIN JOURNEYS

These epic train adventures take you from UNESCO rainforests to arid outback plains









ustralia is known for its vast landscapes, beautiful coastlines and unique wildlife and a train journey is one of the most spectacular ways to explore this diverse country.

THE GHAN

The Ghan is one of Australia's most iconic and luxurious train journeys, offering a unique mix of desert landscapes and outback beauty. The 2,979km trip runs from Adelaide to Darwin (or vice versa), passing through Alice Springs and Katherine Gorge, with activities such as guided tours, cultural talks, bush walks and helicopter rides. Named after the Afghan cameleers who once crossed the central desert, this journey is a must for those seeking adventure.

The Gold Twin Service Cabins feature a sleeper cabin with an ensuite and convertible upper and lower berths. Platinum Service offers even more luxury, with spacious suites, panoramic views, double or twin beds, a full-size ensuite and access to the Platinum Club for all-day dining and beverages.

KURANDA SCENIC RAILWAY

The Kuranda Scenic Railway is another unforgettable journey, running from Cairns to Kuranda through lush rainforest and deep gorges. This 30km route takes about two hours and offers breathtaking views of the Coral Sea and Great Barrier Reef. Originally built in the 1880s, the railway showcases incredible engineering feats.

Passengers can travel in Heritage Class or Gold Class, where they enjoy club-style seating, snacks and drinks in a Victorian-inspired lounge car. The trip concludes at the Kuranda Station, surrounded by tropical greenery.

THE INDIAN PACIFIC

The Indian Pacific is a transcontinental adventure, spanning 4,352km from Sydney to Perth. The four-day journey takes passengers through landscapes ranging from the Blue Mountains to the Nullarbor, featuring the world's longest straight stretch of railway. Along the way, travellers can enjoy wine tasting in the Barossa Valley, a visit to the historic village of Hahndorf, and dinner under the stars in Rawlinna, Western Australia.

Passengers on the Indian Pacific have the same choice of service levels as travellers on The Ghan: the all-inclusive and superbly comfortable Gold Class or the sumptuous service and accommodation of Platinum Class.

WEST COAST WILDERNESS RAILWAY

Climb aboard the West Coast Wilderness Railway for a 35km ride through Tasmania's temperate rainforest on a vintage steam train. Built in the 1890s, the railway reopened in 2002. Passengers can take forest walks, pan for gold and watch the train turn on a manual turntable.

Half and full-day experiences are available and passengers can choose from a Heritage Carriage, with drinks and snacks available for purchase, or fully inclusive catering, plus a glass of Tasmanian sparkling wine in the Wilderness Carriage.

SPIRIT OF THE OUTBACK

Lastly, the Spirit of the Outback runs 1,325km between Brisbane and Longreach, providing stunning views of Queensland's coast and outback. From Brisbane the train runs parallel to the coast through Bundaberg and Gladstone as far as Rockhampton then turns inland to Emerald, Barcaldine and finally Longreach.

Choose from economy or plush first-class cabins, with meals included for first-class travellers. A peaceful escape, enjoy both tropical and outback landscapes.

The Ghan Expedition 2026
